ATTENTION: RESERVE DEPUTY CANDIDATES:

The Adams County Sheriff's Office will start training for Part-Time/Reserve Officers on January 8, 2018 at the accredited Southwest Mississippi Regional Training Academy. Tuition for this training is \$350.00 made payable to the Southwest Mississippi Regional Training Academy.

Mississippi Minimum Standards and Training Act require that Part-Time/Reserve/Auxiliary Law Enforcement Officers receive certification by successfully completing a Basic 305 hour course of instruction in practical law enforcement. An application for certification and agency background investigation are required. In addition, students will be required to submit a completed medical examination form prior to being accepted for enrollment. Please make arrangements with you family physician or health clinic to complete this portion of the application.

Applicants are required to pass at least 50% of the entry physical fitness test at the beginning of the class and have a minimum level of 70% to graduate from the program. A copy of the minimum physical fitness testing requirements as promulgated by the Board on Law Enforcement Officer Standards and Training will be provided.

Applicants are also required to successfully pass an emergency vehicle driving course as well as firearms qualifications and certification.

Classes will be held Monday – Thursday from 6 p.m. – 10 p.m. and on Saturday from 8 a.m. – 5 p.m. The Director of training reserve the right to change dates, locations and specific classes subject to the instructor and weather changes.

Students will be expected to dress appropriately by wearing khaki BTU type pants and a white or black polo shirt. You will also be required to bring appropriate classroom tools to class.

Entrance physical fitness exam will be held at the Natchez High School Track Field, 7 a.m., January 6, 2018. Firearms qualification will be held the afternoon of January 6, 2018 from noon until.
