Press Release

In the early morning hours of May 8, 2019, deputies with the Adams County Special Operations Group executed a narcotics search warrant at 108 Ram Circle. During the execution of the search warrant, Jeremy Williams was found in his bedroom and Chris Coombs was found hiding in the closet in the back bedroom. Agents located three ecstasy tablets, less than 30 grams of marijuana, digital scales, 2 bottles of Promethazine and \$686.00 on Coombs' person and his belongings in the living room.

In Williams bedroom, agents located 35 Zanax bars, 29 Hydrocodone tablets both of which were in unlabeled prescription bottles, digital scales, approximately 12 ounces of high grade marijuana, 5 bottles of Promethazine, a loaded 12 gauge shotgun, a stolen 9 mm pistol, and \$1,287.00.

Outside parked in the driveway was a 2006 Nissan Sentra, that Williams had been driving, and contained approximately four ounces of marijuana in the trunk of the car.

Christopher Combs was charged with Possession of Marijuana (less than 30 grams), Possession of Sch I (Esctasy) within 1500 feet of a school.

Jeremy Williams was charged with Possession of Marijuana with Intent (More than 250 grams) within 1500 feet of a school, Possession of Sch II Drug (Hydrocodone) with Intent within 1500 feet of a school, Possession of Sch IV (Zanax), and Possession of Stolen Firearm.
