Natchez, MS: The Adams County Sheriff's Office have been investigating a rash of Hunting Camp burglaries, dating back to January 2018. On August 8, 2018, while attempting to serve a warrant at 32 Canvas Back Court, deputies discovered numerous items that could possibly be related to these burglaries. Investigators were contacted and arrived on scene and once there, consent was given to search the property. During the investigation at this property, additional information was given that lead to execution of 3 other search warrants (6 Jack Kelly Rd., 8 Pheasant Rd. and 727 Old Hwy 84 No. 3). While searching, various items relating to the hunting camps; such as hunting clothes, tools, appliances, guns and a motorcycle were recovered. The items recovered have an estimated value of over \$40,000. According to Sheriff Patten, the items that have been recovered are linked to at least 8 to 10 hunting camps. Several camp owners have already identified some of their property. Arrested in connection with the burglaries, 26 year old Clinton Blackwell of 6 Jack Kelly Rd., 52 year old Michael Blackwell of 727 Old Hwy 84 No. 3., 37 year old Daniel Grantham of 32 Canvas Back Court., 32 year old Joshua Grantham of 353 NW Byrd St in Roxie, MS. and 22 year old Shaun Campbell of 8 Pheasant Rd. More arrests are pending as investigation is ongoing. Sheriff Patten is advising all camp owners, when leaving your camp for any extended period of time, please take your valuables with you.
