Natchez, MS: On August 30, 2018 deputies responded to an address on Hwy 61 South regarding a burglary. When deputies arrived, they found the rear door open. Surveillance video from the residence showed a blue car pulling up to the residence around 2:00 pm. Once inside, the thieves managed to gather approximately \$20,000 in guns and jewelry. Later that night, deputies received information regarding a possible illegal gun sale in the parking lot of a local convenience store. Deputies went to the store and recovered surveillance video with two male subjects appearing to be engaged in the transfer of a firearm. Based on information received on the identity of the seller, investigators obtained a search warrant for 2037 Lotus Dr. where they recovered numerous stolen items including guns and jewelry. Tyrone McGriff, 28, was arrested at the scene and charged with Burglary of a Residence and Possession of a Stolen Firearm. Dalexus Jones, 19, was also charged with Possession of a Stolen Firearm. Both were booked in to the Adams County Jail. McGriff is currently on parole from MDOC for Burglary stemming from a 2014 Indictment for Burglary of a Dwelling where he was sentenced to 25 years, 18 of which were suspended.
