

ADAMS COUNTY SPECIAL OPERATIONS GROUP

Press Release

On the morning of April 5, 2019, deputies with the Adams County Special Operations Group went to 543 Tate Rd and located Angie Mapp, who was wanted on Drug Trafficking charges. While at the residence, agents discovered a stolen double belt sander and a wood plainer that was taken in a burglary on Longmire Rd. Agents contacted the Criminal Investigation Division (CID), which is also part of the Special Operations Group, to respond to the scene.

Deputies recovered the items and then went to 1318 Highway 61 North and located Terry Huff. After deputies talked to Huff, they went to 47A Proby Rd and located a Honda Foreman 4 wheeler that was believed to have been stolen from a residence on Green Acres Rd. Deputies then went to 8 Pheasant Rd and located a long fin boat motor that was stolen from a residence in Concordia Parish. Continuing with their search, deputies went to 6 Shady Haven Rd and recovered a welder/generator. Investigators are still working on interviewing more witnesses and trying to locate more property in the coming days. Terry Huff has been charged with two counts of receiving stolen property.

Sheriff Patten said this is just one example of how hard these deputies work and communicate with each other. Adams County is blessed to have such passionate and dedicated people in this department. This is only part of the story on Friday though, these deputies with the Special Operations Group also arrested a female for Possession of Methamphetamine at a residence on Old Hwy 84 #3, apprehended a woman that was wanted in Concordia Parish who was hiding in a closet in a residence on Second St, apprehended another male that was wanted for an Indictment in Adams County, and they started the day by participating in a canine demonstration at ACCS that morning.
