Press Release

On the morning of January 28, 2020, the Adams County Special Operations Group executed a narcotics search warrant at 104 Wisteria Lane in Natchez, MS. When officers entered the residence, they encountered James E Marsaw in the living room sleeping on the couch. As they proceeded through the rest of the residence, deputies encounter two small children and Angel Washington.

During a search of the residence, approximately 1 ounce of crack cocaine, 1 ounce of powder cocaine, a small amount of marijuana, a razor blade used to cut the crack cocaine, three digital scales, and a loaded Glock .40 caliber handgun were all found in close proximity of Marsaw.

Marsaw is currently out on felony bond for Sale of Sch II Drug offense from 2018. Marsaw is also out on another felony bond for Possession of Sch II Drug with Intent to Distribute from an arrest on August 28, 2019, which is waiting to be presented to the Adams County Grand Jury.

Marsaw has been arrested and charged with Possession of Sch II Drug to wit Cocaine with Intent to Distribute and Possession of Sch II Drug to wit Crack Cocaine with Intent to Distribute and Possession of Drug Paraphernalia.

The District Attorney's Office has filed a motion in Circuit Court to revoke Marsaw's bond.
